The College Campus is being divided into two parts, a two storied new building and the other is the old one storied building, midst which there is a green playground. The campus is unique for its spacious green forest situated behind the new building. The College has friendly and congenial ambience for teaching Under the British Rule Falakata was a Sub-divisional town but after independence, the centre of gravity has been shifted to Alipurduar. As a result, the old glory of Falakata decreased day by day. Surrounded by tea gardens and forests, far away from both the District town Jalpaiguri and Sub-divisional town Alipurduar, the people of Falakata found it very difficult to keep in touch with higher Education. It was an agriculture based area majority of the maximum number of population belonged to backward scheduled class and scheduled tribes. Though the students were eager to get them admitted into Colleges but it was beyond their capacity. Hence, the need for establishing a College was felt. As a result, Falakata College was born on 19th September, 1981. Later the College had been included under section (on) 28.05.1988. 2(f) 12(b) the **UGC** The tiny sapling of 1981 is now young flourishing tree which has seen 29 springs in its life and is now meting out education to thousand of students every year. One can't but be amazed at the growth of the institution looking back to the year 1981 when it started functioning with 50/60 students on the roll.

# Online Admision 2016-2017

Notification Dt. 01.06.2016

As per the order no. 396-Edn (CS)/10M-95/14, dated 29.04.2016 of Higher Education Department, Govt. of West Bengal, from the Academic year 2016-2017, admission to Under Graduate (Honours & General) in State-Aided Higher Educational Institutions in West Bengal (except institutions recognized as minority institutions) shall be through online-merit-based admission system.

Students passing H.S. (10+2) Examination from WBCHSE or other Recognised Boards Provided he/she has passed with at least Four subjects with English as Compulsory subject, excluding Environmental studies/Science/Education are eligible to get application forms from the college (www.admissionfalakatacollege.org.in & also a link www.falakata.org.in ) Intending and eligible candidates are to submit separate application forms for Honours and / or General Stream. Admission is made strictly on the basis of merit and as per procedure laid down by the Admission Committee of the college. The dates of Registration, Publication of Merit lists, Admission will be uploaded time to time. If any candidate fails to get himself/herself admitted by the specified date he/she will forfeit his/her claim for admission.

Reservation of Seats: As per Govt. order vide Memo no. 905-TW/EC, dated 12 Sept.-1995, 22% are reserved for SC, 6% for S.T. candidates and as per Govt. order vide memo no. 83-Edn/(T) 10M-48/14, dated 28/02/2014, 10% are reserved for OBC -A, and 7 % for OBC-B candidates including 3% of reservation for Disable students of all categories. All such candidates are required to have the S.C./S.T./OBC-A, OBC-B (, Disability Certificate in support of their claim for admission.

Payment of Rs. 100/- only per application form and requisite bank charge should be paid to any branch of SBI.

Those students who obtain either (i) 55% marks in aggregate or (ii) 50% in aggregate and 60% in subject are eligible to apply for the admission to Honours Course in the subject concerned.

The SC and ST candidates who obtain (i) 50% marks in aggregate and or (ii) 45% in aggregate and 60% in subject are eligible to apply for the admission to Honours Course in the subject concerned.

Separate Merit List shall be prepared for Honours Course (Subject wise) and General Course. Candidates will be selected according to their Merit Point for each course. Calculation Formula for Merit Point (Honours & General courses) and other necessary information's and schedule for admission are given below.

# **STEP-BY-STEP PROCESS:**

### **STEP 1:** (SUMISSION OF APPLICATION FORM)

Before filling in Form, applicants have to scan their recent passport size photograph for uploading it in the Form by using CHOOSE FILE button (Size of photograph should not more than 100 kb). They have to click "APPLY ONLINE" button to submit necessary data like name, date of birth, address, caste/category, contact no., subject marks etc. very carefully.

### STEP 2: (CONFIRMATION OF FORM, PAYMENT OF REGISTRATION FEES AND PRINT OUT OF FORM & PAYMENT SLIP/BANK CHALLAN)

After submitting that, a Confirm Page of the Form will be displayed in the monitor for Confirmation of all data by the applicants and they have to select Payment Option ("Online Payment" / "Offline Payment") for payment of the Application Fees. (*Applicants may click "BACK" button for any correction, and submit again*)

- i) PAYMENT THROUGH ONLINE: If the applicants wish to pay requisite Application Fees by using Credit Card/ Debit Card/IMPS/Net Banking, they have to click "ONLINE PAYMENT" button and then follow step-by-step process. In this process they have to take print out of Form & Online Payment Slip and submit the Form and Xerox copy of this Payment Slip & other Original documents to the college office at the time of Verification .
- ii) **PAYMENT THROUGH OFFLINE**: If the applicants wish to deposit requisite Application/Registration Fees through Bank Challan, they have to click "OFFLINE PAYMENT" button and take printout of the Form and TWO PARTS OF BANK CHALLAN, of which
  - a) the *Bank Part* has to be submitted to any branch of **STATE BANK OF INDIA** with requisite Application / Registration Fees,
  - b) the *College Part* has to be submitted to the college office at the time of Verification .

NOTE: Without payment of Application/Registration Fees, No forms will be considered for Merit List.

### **STEP 3**: (PAYMENT STATUS CHECKING)

Applicants are advised to check the Payment Status of their Forms <u>after four hour from the date of depositing/payment of application fees</u>, through "PAYMENT STATUS" button by using their Application ID No. as User ID and Date of Birth as Password. The Form will be displayed as "PAID"; otherwise, it will be displayed as "UNPAID". If the Form is not displayed as "PAID" even after four hour from the date of depositing/payment of application fees, the applicants are advised to contact with the Bank and take necessary steps within the time scheduled positively. Only "PAID" Forms will be considered for Merit List.

 $Merit Point = \underline{2S + T}$ 

2S = Marks obtained in the subject opted for Honours x 2

T = English Marks + Marks obtained in the subject opted for Honours +

Best Marks of only other two subjects (Excluding the marks secured in Environment
Studies/Science/Education and Marks obtained in the subject opted for Honours.)

Example = MERIT= 2 x 60 (Honours Subject) + 65 (English) + 60 (Honours subject)  
+70 + 75 (Best Two Subjects)  
= 
$$\frac{2 \times 60 + 65 + 60 + 70 + 75}{6}$$
  
= 65

# MERIT POINT CALCULATION FORMULA (FOR GENERAL COURSE):

Merit Point = 
$$\frac{T1}{4}$$

T1 = Marks Obtained in English + Best of Other Three Subjects(Excluding the marks secured in Environment Studies/Science/Education)

Example = MERIT= 60 (English marks) + 75 + 72 + 63 (Best of other Three Subjects) / 4
$$= \frac{60 + 75 + 72 + 63}{4}$$
= 67.5
